 - 4. Traffic and pedestrian infrastructure improvements to the surrounding neighborhood.
 - 5. Evaluation of appropriate storm water runoff.
 - 6. Bond for damages to current homes due to excavation, construction, and other related activities that impact the exiting flow of natural fluids (water) and gas (radon).
 - a. Foundation and footing damage to current homes caused by drilling.
