 - Kitty Klitzke was the council representative that attended the meeting. Regarding the city's budget:
 - claimed the council has already found \$2 million in budget savings but she didn't detail the specific cuts they had found.
 - O Dennis attended the May 20 City Council meeting and believes the \$2M in "savings" is actually budget gimmickry, where they are refinancing older bonds at lower rates to newer bonds at higher rates that skip payment in 2024
 - claimed being new put her at a disadvantage answering the tough budget question and passed blame onto the last administration for using Covid \$ to delay the problem and the union raises they needed to attract better police/fire candidates.

- 3. Michael talked with Marc (UCUT?). Marc has been very active and has secured a written guarantee adding the city lots to the park, is actively seeking investors to purchase the 5 lots across from the development and led two school tours of the park last week. He said he will be attending a future neighborhood meeting at your house to report this progress.
- 4. The developer requested an extension, so the notification signs haven't been posted yet and the date of the Hearing Examiner meeting has not yet been established.

Also, if you would like to speak at the Public Hearing, watch for the sign that will be posted, follow the directions -you have to write-in to speak.

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
